<b>Title and abstract of the doctoral thesis</b>
The study of business partnerships and their rulings in Islamic jurisprudence (a comparative legal study (with the positive laws))
This study deals with the topic of business partnerships and their rulings, due to their great importance in supporting the movement of economic activity, especially in the contemporary reality in which the costs and expenses of tools and equipment used in professional work have increased. This requires the creation of economic clusters based on Islamic principles and controls that are compatible with the contemporary economic reality. Business partnerships are one of the solutions that contribute to providing material possibilities and facilitating the practice of economic activity in the field of professions and artisanal work. This study is comprehensive in its coverage of the topic in order to fulfill all aspects related to it, God willing. This is from the legal, legal, and contemporary application aspects. This study includes an introduction and five chapters. The introduction discusses the definition of a company in general, in terms of its concept and its divisions in Islamic jurisprudence and the positive law. Chapter One discusses the concept of a business partnership, its legality, the nature of its contract, and the divisions mentioned therein. Chapter Two discusses the pillars of a business partnership and the health conditions of each pillar in three sections. The first section discusses the formula and its related provisions. The second section deals with the contracting parties and their eligibility, especially the partnership of a Muslim with a non-Muslim, due to the importance of the topic in the contemporary time, in which foreign companies have

entered Arab countries. The third section deals with the subject matter, where it discusses the conditions of work, profit and loss, and the comparison of these conditions with the provisions of the positive law. Chapter Three discusses the rulings of a business partnership in two sections. The first section deals with the rulings of a valid business partnership, focusing on the rulings of work as the essential element in forming a business partnership, and the rules for dividing profit and loss, considering that profit is the purpose of the partners in the company. The second section deals with the rulings of an invalid business partnership, and then compares the topics of this chapter with contemporary laws. Chapter Four discusses the causes of the termination of a business partnership in two sections. The first section discusses the compulsory causes for the termination of a business partnership, and in the second section the optional causes. The causes for the termination of a business partnership have been dealt with in the light of the causes for the termination of a company in general, and compared to the law. Chapter Five discusses the contemporary application of a business partnership, which is civil professional companies, and their research in the law, and comparing that with the rulings of Islamic law, in three sections. The first section discusses the definition of professional companies, the second section clarifies the pillars of professional companies according to the pillars of a company in general in the positive law, and the third section discusses the rulings of professional companies in comparison with Islamic law. Finally, the conclusion contains the most important results of the research.
