Degree Overview

Audiology and Speech Language Pathology is a healthcare profession specializing in identifying, diagnosing, and rehabilitative services for hearing and speech disorders. The program is designed to equip students with fundamental academic knowledge, clinical skills, and reflective practices, preparing them to excel in the fields of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology. BSc ASLP graduates from the University of Sharjah will be empowered to make significant contributions in various clinical roles in healthcare settings.

Program Goals

- Provide students with high-quality, intellectually challenging education in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology.
- Apply broad theoretical knowledge and clinical skills in audiological and speech-language disorders, fostering effectiveness in communication, problem-solving, and evidence-based practice.

- Graduate the students with high level teaching and professional training that enable them to pass the national and international licensure and board exams

- A minimum average of 85% for General Track or equivalent. Students should achive 75% in Math subject and one science subject (Biology or Chemistry) in high school.
