### AOCMF Regional Course Advances in Mid and Upper-Face Trauma

13-14 October, 2019

This face-to-face AOCMF course focused on best practices and state-of-the-art techniques in managing mid and upper facial trauma at an advanced level using human anatomical specimens. Strong emphasis was given to workflow optimization according to AO principles while addressing clinical controversies.
