POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN ULTRASOUND TECHNOLOGY APPLICATIONS PROGRAM





Sharjah Surgical Institute, University of Sharjah together with College of Graduate Studies launched Postgraduate Diploma in Ultrasound Technology Applications designed to address unmet needs of the Obstetrics and Gynecology (OBG) specialist and consultants on 18th September, 2020. The program helps to equip participants with the core knowledge and skills in using ultrasound technology during pregnancy and interpreting fetal ultrasound images as well as US images of female reproductive pathologies. This program targets OBG specialists practicing in UAE and the region. It is based on best international and regional practice in similar programs. It takes into consideration the requirements to develop and update OBG skills in the discipline.

The PGDUS program is modular structure comprising nine modules and a comprehensive assessment of knowledge, skills and professionalism. Primary Total Knee Replacement Instructional **Course - Attune**

1st March, 2020

This instructional course was a combination of presentations, panel discussions and cadaveric workshops and focused on primary total knee arthroplasty. It addressed the challenges faced in primary knee surgery as well as current advances in primary TKA. The cadaveric workshops allowed the opportunity to become familiar with the surgical workflow, instruments and techniques used with the ATTUNE Knee.



Primary Hip Arthroplasty course

2nd March, 2020

This course ensured teaching Primary Hip Arthroplasty, Patient selection, expectation, Prosthesis selection, considerations in selecting a prosthesis, clinical data, avoiding & managing common challenges. The sessions included: lectures, discussion forums and Cadaveric hands on session.

Revision Hip Arthroplasty Instructional Course

3rd March, 2020

This instructional course was highly practical, with presentations and extensive anatomic lab work. The focus of the course was on patient selection and surgical technique needed to safely implant the Revision Hip portfolio: RECLAIM®, GRIPTION® TI-FOAM, CORAIL® Revision and PINNACLE®.





Emergency Medicine Residency Program Sheikh Khalifa Medical City Procedure training session

4th March, 2020

The course focused on hands-on training on Animal to practice, Skin suturing, IO insertion, Tendon repair, Lateral canthotomy, Needle decompression, Thoracentesis, Paracentesis, Pericardiocentesis, Surgical airway/cricothyrotomy and Thoracostomy/ Resuscitative thoracotomy.



- Robotic Urology






Laparoscopic Surgery & COVID-19 - Free Online Webinar



21-22 July, 2020





Physiotherapy for Sports Injury (Online Course)


28th August, 2020

Sharjah Clinical and Surgical Traning Center successfully organized 36 Life Support Courses from March till September, 2020.


The courses that were conducted at the center were 5 ACLS, 26 BLS, 2 First Aid, 2 NRP and 1 ACLS Instructor course.


SSI is the authorized American Heart Association Training Center in UAE and has been successfully conducting the life support courses since many years.






