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Mean Scores% - Checklist Domains

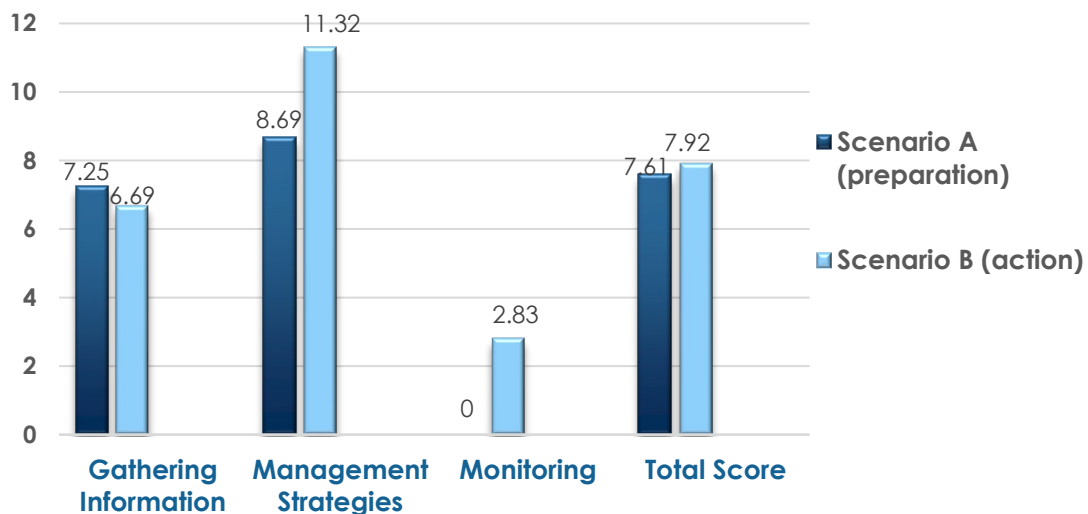


Figure 1- Comparison between the performances in both scenarios

Highlights:

- All the pharmacists did not achieve the minimum cut scores for passing, thus all of them failed
- Overall performance of community pharmacists in the city of Sharjah, UAE was inadequate.
- Pharmacists weren't qualified enough to provide safe, effective, and person-centered care in response to smokers seeking assistance with quitting.
- Pharmacists should be trained and educated to deliver evidence-based smoking cessation services.
