



The College of Sciences have fostered the following activities during from September 10 to September 24, 2020:

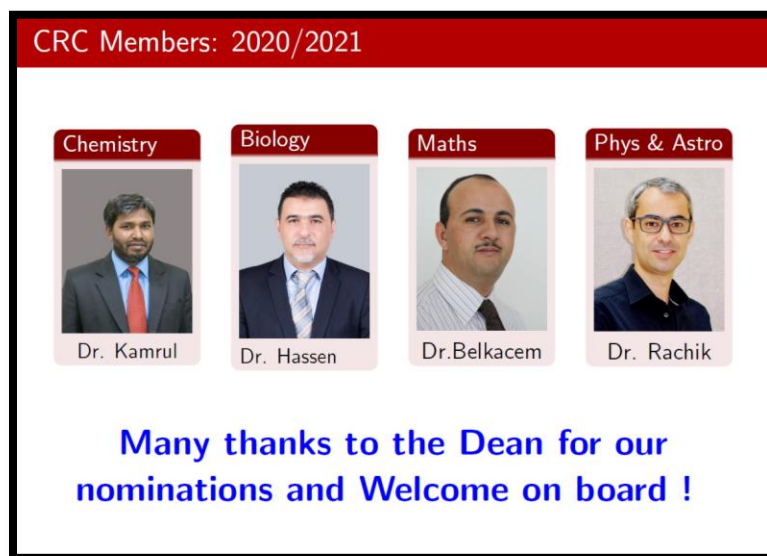

- c. Open discussion



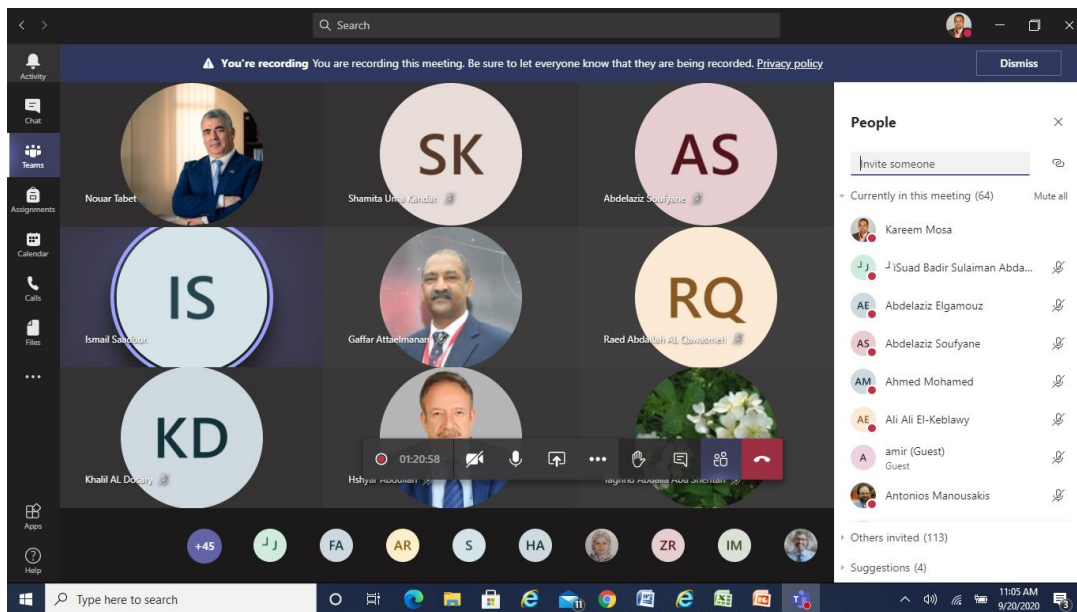
