Generally, it is the practice educator who holds responsibility for ensuring that the contributing elements of a practice education placement cover all relevant learning outcomes." (Health and Care Professions, 2016). A practice educator is *not* a link lecturer, supervisor or mentor though some elements of the roles may overlap. It is recommended that practice educators are accredited by the College of Radiographers.
